The entire Atlantic family is very proud of this wonderful young athlete and his very special father.

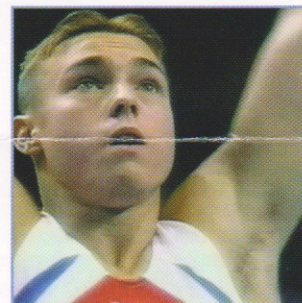
